

What is a sub-domain?

In the URL <http://real-estate.delcourt.com> , **real-estate** is a sub-domain of **delcourt.com**

The sub-domain is only a name. This name must be unique over internet and can only assign to one person/one company..

This name must be reserved. The reservation can be done for one or several years (today it is possible to reserve a domain name up to 100 years).

Some examples of sub-domains:

- dominic.delcourt.com
- real-estate.delcourt.co
- joe.delcourt.me
- catherine.delcourt.co
- lukas.delcourt.tv

Mails andt web-site... ?

"Services" are associated to the name.

From the sub-domain name it is therefore possible to create:

- one or many e-mails

- a classic web site (Blog, Photo gallery, ...)
- a secured web site (donc it requires authentication meaning password and login)

Which characters are authorised in a sub-domainname ?

A sub-domain can contain the following characters :

- the letters from **a** to **z**
- the digit from **0** to **9**
- the characters plus (« + »), point (« . ») and (« - »)

Is there a difference between small and capital letters ?

On the internet, there is no difference between small and capital and letters
Hence REAL-ESTATE.delcourt.com and real-estate.delcourt.com are identical.
